Works by Haydn, Brahms, Bartók, Leó Weiner and Gene Pritsker trace the influence of "Gypsy" music – the bewitching blend of European folk themes and traditional Roma songs - through two centuries. Three new works written for violinist Lara St. John highlight the evening.

LISZT: REVOLUTIONARY ROMANTIC

SATURDAY, JUNE 25, 8 PM

The Festival salutes the great Romantic virtuoso and composer Franz Liszt on the 200th anniversary of his birth. Host-narrator Michael Roeder illuminates the harmonic complexity and radical elements of Liszt's works with stories and comments woven into the concert program. Works include the evocative *Vallée d'Obermann* and the dramatic *Mephisto Waltz*.

SUNDAY, JUNE 26, 3 PM

Classics from the chamber music repertoire close the Festival. The program includes Anton Arensky's Piano Trio no. 1, a gracefully melodic, at times elegiac work, and Robert Schumann's Piano Quintet in E-flat Major. Written not long after his marriage to the pianist Clara Wieck, it is an expression of their shared musical passions and a tribute to her virtuosity.






JASMINE LIN, violin

Co-founder of the award-winning Gryphon Trio, a violinist of "regal elegance"




CHARLES PILON, viola

Co-founder of the Gryphon Trio, an artist with the "powerful heart of a true Romantic"




MARINA HOOVER, cello
